IN CASE OF EMERGENCY PUT ICE IN YOUR MOBILE PHONE

Member for Ipswich, Rachel Nolan is encouraging Ipswich residents to put ICE in their mobile phones.

Ms Nolan said that everyone should put a phone number of their next of kin in their mobile phone in case of emergencies – headed ICE.

“I encourage people to put an ‘in case of emergency’ number in their mobile phone,” Ms Nolan said.

“This is a campaign encouraging people to store personal details on their mobile phones to help identify victims of accidents and disasters which has come to our attention since the London bombings.

“Mobile phone users are being urged to enter a number in their phone’s memory under the heading “i-c-e” – in case of emergency.

“The phone number could be headed ICE wife or ICE brother, or ICE father and so on.” she said.

Ms Nolan said the ICE system could be very helpful to paramedics if they come across an accident scene where a person may be unconscious and they need to contact their next of kin for vital information about their health and medication needs.
