INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS WELCOMED BY NOLAN

The Department of Main Roads is proposing to install a right-turn slot at the intersection of Brisbane Road and Stafford Street, Booval to improve safety and traffic flow, Member for Ipswich Rachel Nolan said today.

The proposed works will include a new right-turn lane on the eastern approach (Brisbane Road) of the intersection and a remodel of the traffic signals to fully control the right-turn movements from this approach.

“These improvements will make a huge difference to the traffic flow along Brisbane Road which is gradually becoming busier and busier as the population increases in Ipswich,” Ms Nolan said.

“Part of the upgrade will include upgrading existing signals and also pedestrian ramps and crossings to current standards.”

A detailed design of the intersection will be finalised after reviewing community feedback and construction is expected to commence in August 2006 and expected to be completed in October 2006, weather permitting.
