## **\$320,623 increase in supplemental funding to non-government service providers in Ipswich**

Member for Ipswich and Minister for Transport Rachel Nolan MP today announced that supplementary funding would be provided to non-government community service providers in Ipswich.

The funding allocation is in response to the Queensland Government's awareness of the various pressures experienced by funded non-government organisations, including those arising from the recent Queensland Industrial relations Commission's decision on award rates. It demonstrates the Bligh Government's dual commitment to jobs in the community sector and to protecting the most vulnerable Queenslanders.

"Funding has been allocated to 20 non-government service providers in Ipswich with \$303,447 in 2009-10 and increasing to \$624,082 recurrent in 2012-13. This demonstrates the Bligh Government's continued support for the sector's vital work," said Ms Nolan.

"This additional funding has been prioritised and allocated to those services delivering to fully dependant and vulnerable clients, for example, families escaping domestic violence." Ms Nolan said.
