There were 89 prizes of \$300 bike shop vouchers up for grabs in the competition – one winner in each State electorate.

"I'm delighted that Naomi has been selected as the winner from our community and I hope that she enjoys her new bike," Ms Nolan said.

Ms Nolan said the challenge, conducted online in the lead-up to and during Bike Week, was a terrific success.

"We had a fantastic response with close to 3000 entries received from students all over Queensland," Ms Nolan said.

"The competition was established to raise awareness of the benefits of sustainable transport, the importance of being active from an early age and to get more people out and about on bikes.

"Riding a bike to school is great exercise for children and teaches them important road safety skills, and it also helps to reduce congestion on our roads.
